Cuisine:

Our amazing chef Dale Keith has 30 years of experience as a chef and restaurateur, most notably with Vista Café, The White Swan and as creator of the eponymous Mt Victoria & Thorndon Chipperies. We are fortunate to be based in bountiful Wairarapa where we have access to so many local farms and orchards that provide us the freshest fruit, vegetables and meat. Everything we serve is made from scratch is the true farm to table experience.

Catering prices range from \$140.00 - \$150.00 per person. This includes a 3 course menu with supper, cutlery, crockery, glassware and waiting staff.

Beverages:

You are welcome to bring in your own beverages which we will serve for you. Note there is a small handling fee for BYO* beverages. We can also help you select and supply some wonderful Wairarapa wine and beer at discounted prices. The average budget to allow for your beverages ranges from \$50.00 per person.

The basic formula for the required amount at a wedding is:

- 6 - 8 bottles of beer per male
- ½ bottle of bubbles per guest
- 1 bottle of wine per person

This amount is based on our experience but you may like to adjust to your specific needs. We have a large walk in chiller and will supply ice to keep your drinks at the perfect temperature. We have an extensive range of glassware to serve your beverages.

Dale has extensive knowledge on all things to do with beverages and has great relationships with our local suppliers and has selected the every best local wine, beer and gin for you to enjoy. The Rose & Smith selection is charged on consumption, which allows you to offer a wide selection of wine varieties and you are supporting a local business. Wine tastings are held throughout the year or at your menu tasting meeting.

Wedding rehearsal and set up:

We aim to have your wedding rehearsal at 4.00pm the day before your wedding.

- If there is another wedding the day before yours, we will need your rehearsal to be slightly earlier at 1.00pm.
- Weddings are normally booked 6-18 months in advance so we will be able to give you plenty of warning.

The tables will be set up the day before ready for any stationery and styling. We are also happy to do this for you if you prefer and supply us with your styling items.

Your beverages and any other items can also be delivered the day before. We will manage all other vendor pack in and pack outs for you.
